



Report on Breast Cancer Awareness and Scanning Programme held at Govt Degree College Santirbazar

Date: 29/11/2023

Govt Degree College Santirbazar organised Breast Cancer Awareness and Scanning Programme in the college premises on 29/11/2023. The programme was organized in association with a Mumbai-based NGO "Suadha" and Santirbazar Press Club.

The Chief Guest on the occasion was the Honorable SDM of Santribazar, Shri. Abhedananda Baidya. He told women students to be aware of their health risks and encouraged them to take part in the screening. A screening machine was set up in the college where female students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff underwent testing. The women from the nearby villages also visited the college to get their screening done.

Iva Athavia, the Managing Director of Suadha supervised the screening programme. In the inaugural programme she told the students of the college that women are at the risk of developing cancer after 40 years of age. She also held a private presentation with the girl students to teach them about the anatomy of women's bodies and how they can detect any lumps at an early stage.

Distinguished resource persons included Dr. Kuldip Gosai Assistant Professor and HOD of Environmental Science, Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar College, Belonia, South Tripura; Shri Ashis Malakar, Agriculture Officer, CEV, Birchandra Manu, Santirbazar, South Tripura. other dignatories were Dr. Sanjoy Das, Principal-in-charge of the college; Sri Dipak Hrishi Das, TC Secretary at GDC, Santirbazar; and Shri Sajal Nama, Convener of the Seminar and Coordinator of IQAC.

In his welcoming address, Shri Sajal Nama, the Convener of the seminar and Coordinator of IQAC, Government Degree College Santirbazar, expressed sincere gratitude to the esteemed guests, participants, and students for their presence. He articulated the primary objective of the program is to foster widespread awareness regarding the conservation of wetlands, emphasizing their critical role as integral components of biodiversity and their significance in the water cycle. Shri Nama underscored that wetlands constitute ecosystems that sustain intricate food chains and highlighted their paramount importance for environmental stability. He elucidated that Wetlands serve as crucial habitats for diverse flora and fauna, providing breeding grounds and shelter for numerous species. Moreover, they act as natural filtration systems, purifying water and mitigating the impacts of pollution. Additionally, wetlands contribute to flood control, shoreline stabilization, and climate regulation, thus offering multifaceted ecological benefits. By elucidating the multifaceted ecological significance of wetlands, Shri Nama aimed to instill a sense of urgency and responsibility among attendees towards their

preservation. He emphasized the imperative of collective action and informed decision-making to safeguard these invaluable ecosystems for present and future generations.

Mr. Dipak Hrishi Das, Secretary of the Teachers' Council at Government Degree College Santirbazar, underscored the diverse typology of wetlands and their pivotal role in sustaining life-sustaining environments for humanity. He accentuated the necessity of preserving these wetlands to ensure human well-being. Mr. Das emphasized how wetlands provide crucial ecosystem services, including water purification, flood mitigation, and habitat provision for various species, thereby directly impacting human livelihoods and quality of life. His remarks aimed to highlight the interconnectedness between wetland conservation and human welfare, urging concerted efforts towards their protection and sustainable management.

During his presidential address, **Dr. Sanjoy Das**, Principal-In-Charge of Government Degree College Santirbazar, elucidated the indispensable role of wetlands in our ecosystem and the imperative for their preservation. Dr. Das expounded upon the myriad ecological services provided by wetlands, such as water filtration, flood control, and biodiversity conservation. He articulated the adverse consequences of wetland degradation, emphasizing the need to abstain from activities that pollute these vital habitats. Dr. Das underscored that preserving wetlands is essential for maintaining environmental balance, safeguarding biodiversity, and ensuring sustainable development, thus advocating for concerted efforts to protect and restore these invaluable ecosystems.

Resource person **Shri Ashis Malakar**, Agriculture Officer from CEV Birchandra Manu, provided a comprehensive overview of the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands, detailing its significance and the various categories under which wetlands are classified. He delved into the Ramsar listed wetland sites in Tripura, as well as other prominent wetland sites across India, emphasizing their ecological importance.

Mr. Malakar elaborated on the diverse benefits that wetlands offer, including medicinal resources, support for livelihoods through fisheries and agriculture, provision of freshwater, flood control by absorbing excess water, and serving as carbon sinks, mitigating climate change impacts. He underscored the critical need to protect and preserve wetlands due to their multifaceted ecological roles and the services they provide to both humans and the environment.

Highlighting the Ramsar Convention's global recognition of the importance of wetlands, Mr. Malakar stressed the necessity for concerted conservation efforts. He emphasized that wetlands are not only vital habitats for numerous species but also essential for maintaining biodiversity and ecological balance. Furthermore, he emphasized that wetlands are crucial for sustaining various ecosystem services upon which human well-being depends. In conclusion, Mr. Malakar's detailed discussion

underscored the imperative of safeguarding wetlands, not only for their intrinsic ecological value but also for their crucial contributions to human welfare and environmental sustainability.

Another resource person of the seminar, **Dr. Kuldip Gosai**, Assistant Professor and HOD, Department of Environmental Science, Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar College, Belonia, South Tripura, elucidated the factors contributing to the decline in wetland areas. He underscored that the reduction in wetland coverage can be attributed to multiple causes, including climate change-induced alterations in precipitation patterns, fluctuations in water levels, and extensive human intervention.

Dr. Gosai emphasized that climate change, characterized by shifts in temperature and rainfall patterns, has profound implications for wetlands worldwide. These alterations disrupt the hydrological balance essential for wetland ecosystems, leading to their degradation and loss. Additionally, he highlighted human activities such as urbanization, agricultural expansion, and industrialization as significant drivers of wetland depletion. These anthropogenic pressures often result in habitat destruction, pollution, and alteration of natural drainage patterns, exacerbating the decline in wetland areas.

Furthermore, Dr. Gosai shed light on the rich biodiversity supported by wetland ecosystems. He discussed the myriad species that depend on wetlands for their survival, including various migratory birds, aquatic plants, amphibians, and fish. These species rely on wetlands for breeding, nesting, feeding, and shelter, making wetlands crucial for maintaining ecological balance and supporting biological diversity. In summation, Dr. Gosai's insights underscored the intricate relationship between human activities, environmental changes, and the decline of wetland areas. His discussion highlighted the urgent need for concerted conservation efforts to mitigate the threats facing wetlands and safeguard the invaluable ecosystems they support.
