MEMORANDUM

Sub: Organizing Awareness Programme cum Seminar on different provision of Protection of Civil Rights Act, 1955 and Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in different Government Degree Colleges.

Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015 and Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Rules, 2016 have been published in the Extraordinary issue of the Tripura Gazette No.311 dated, 31st August, 2016. The National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST), Government of India and the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC), Government of India have emphasized on creating awareness on the aforesaid Acts and Rules among the common people.

2. It has been decided by the Government that Awareness Programme cum Seminar on various aspects of the Protection of Civil Rights Act, 1955 the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Amendment Act, 2015 and Amendment Rules, 2016 would be organized in all 22 (twenty two) nos. Government Degree College through concerned Colleges for wide dissemination of information about the provisions of the aforesaid Acts & Rules. The list of Government Degree Colleges is enclosed at Annexure-1.

3. For each Awareness Programme cum Seminar an amount of Rs.17,000/- (Rupees seventeen thousand) would be provided from the Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Government of Tripura. Tentative expenditure plan for each awareness programme to be organized would be as follows:

Sl.	Item	Proposed Expenditure
1.	Honorarium for the the 4 nos. Resource persons (from Home Department and Law Department / Advocate)	@ 750 x 4 = 3,000/-
2.	Refreshment for the participants (targeted participants 200)	@ 50 x 200 = 10,000/-
3.	Banner, Sound System, Hall arrangement	Rs. 2,500/-
4.	Photography, report preparation and Misc.	Rs. 1,500/-
5.	Expenditure for each Awareness Programme	Rs. 17,000/-
6.	Total Expenditure for 22 nos. Awareness programme @ Rs. 17,000/- X 22 = 3,74,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh seventy four thousand) only.	

4. At least, one Resource person from Home department and one Resource person from Law Department should be invited for discussion on various aspects of the Protection of Civil Right Act. 1955 and Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. 1989.

5. The booklet published by the Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. Of Tripura on different provisions of Protection of Civil Right Act. 1955 and Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. 1989, Amendment Act, 2015 should be distributed during the Awareness Programme. All Principal of the Government Degree Colleges will take necessary arrangement for collection of booklet from the Directorate of Tribal Welfare well in advance.

6. The awareness programme cum Seminar should be organized within March, 2020. Brief report on the Awareness Programmes organized along with UC, photographs and list of participants is required to be submitted to the Directorate of Welfare for Scheduled Tribes, Government of Tripura.

7. All the District Welfare Officers will coordinate with the respective Sub-Divisional Welfare Officers for smooths and early completion of the programme.
