



1. NCC cadets distributed national flags and batch to each and every student.
2. Marathon race held on 25/07/2023 on the occasion of the "75 Seemanta Gram Kranti Veero Ke Naam" programme. 19 students participated in the race. The race was conducted in remembrance of forgotten heroes.
3. Youth Festival participation on 23/11/2024: the students of GDC Santirbazar participated in the Youth Festival organized at Santirbazar market. The students showcased their singing and dancing talent as well as took part in the painting competition. This was one of the activities aimed at closing the distance between the students and the local populace. This programme also served as an opportunity to showcase the traditional art forms of the students.
4. Breast Cancer Awareness: The college organized a Breast Cancer Awareness programme in the college on 29/11/2023. The women from the nearby village as well as the women staff of the college underwent the initial breast cancer screening.
5. NSS Volunteers participated in the HIV AIDs rally at Santirbazar market on December 1st to raise awareness against the disease. This rally was organized in association with the Chief Medical Officer's office as well as the local schools and NGOs of the sub-division.
6. Programme against Drugs use on 14/12/2023: NSS Unit and NCC Unit carried out a programme against drug use in the state. The Resource Person on the occasion was Shri. 


Report of Marathon Race Competition






Report on Breast Cancer Awareness and Scanning Programme held at Govt Degree College Santirbazar

Govt Degree College Santirbazar organised Breast Cancer Awareness and Scanning Programme in the college premises on 29/11/2023. The programme was organized in association with a Mumbai-based NGO "Suadha" and Santirbazar Press Club.

The Chief Guest on the occasion was the Honorable SDM of Santirbazar, Shri. Abhedananda Baidya. He told women students to be aware of their health risks and encouraged them to take part in the screening. A screening machine was set up in the college where female students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff underwent testing. The women from the nearby villages also visited the college to get their screening done.

Iva Athavia, the Managing Director of Suadha supervised the screening programme. In the inaugural programme she told the students of the college that women are at the risk of developing cancer after 40 years of age. She also held a private presentation with the girl students to teach them about the anatomy of women's bodies and how they can detect any lumps at an early stage.

Santirbazar**


Date: 14/12/2023

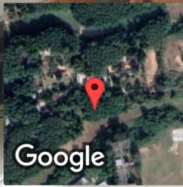
After the important speeches by the Resource Person and the Principal, there was a question-answer round where students and faculty enquired about the nature of punishments that can be given to drug offenders.

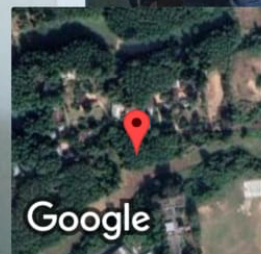

Report on NSS volunteers' participation at the World AIDS Day rally held on 01/12/2023






Report on Voter's Awareness Programme organized by NSS Unit of Govt Degree College Santirbazar




Report: NSS unit, Govt. Degree College Santirbazar organized an Environment Awareness Programme and Plantation Drive


